

The Showerwise Cartridge should be replaced after approximately 12 months of service, depending on your water conditions and usage.

1. Remove Showerwise System from the shower pipe.
2. Open the housing by unscrewing the two halves. (It is not necessary to remove the showerhead.)
3. Remove/discard the old cartridge. Make sure that the Large O-Ring located in the bottom housing is properly seated in the Large O-Ring channel. A small amount of petroleum jelly applied to the Large O-Ring will help hold it in the channel.
4. Remove labels from each end of new cartridge.
5. Apply a small amount of petroleum jelly to the Small O-Ring on the new cartridge.
6. Lubricate the plastic threads of the two halves of the housing with petroleum jelly. This will ensure the housing will be easy to open in the future.
7. Showerwise is a one-way filter. Place the new cartridge—screen side up—in the bottom half of the housing.
8. Close the housing by screwing the two halves back together.
9. Attach Showerwise to shower pipe by hand tightening. Avoid cross threading when starting threads. Do not overtighten.
10. Flush with HOT water for several minutes before first use.

11. Add Teflon tape to any male threads if leaks occur.

NOTE:

To ensure top performance, change filter cartridge after 1 year or 15,000 gallons, whichever comes first.
