IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

A person who has not read and understood all operating and safety instructions is not qualified to operate this appliance. When using this appliance, always adhere to basic safety precautions including:

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USE.



1. Use **INDOORS** only on a dry, level, well-supported, stable surface. **DO NOT** use this appliance outdoors. To reduce the risk of electric shock, **DO NOT** expose this appliance to water or moisture.
2. **DO NOT** operate this appliance in any area where there is risk of the unit falling into or being exposed to water.
3. Keep out of reach of children. This is not a toy! The purifier is an electrical device. Adult supervision is required when operating in the presence of children.
4. Plug Purifier into a 120 volt electrical outlet only.
5. **DO NOT** operate with a damaged plug, after a malfunction or if the purifier has been damaged in any manner. Return to an authorized dealer or authorized service facility for repair or replacement.
6. If an extension cord must be used, its marked electrical rating should be at least as great as the electrical rating of the Purifier. **DO NOT** allow power cord or extension cord to hang over the edge of a counter or contact hot surfaces.
7. **DO NOT** use appliance for other than intended use.
8. **DO NOT** allow foreign objects to enter the intake and outlet openings as this may cause electric shock or damage to the purifier. **DO NOT** block air intake or outlet openings.



CAUTION!

DO NOT look directly or stare at the UV light. **DO NOT** operate lamp module outside of purifier housing.



CAUTION!

To replace the lamp module, press “ON/OFF” switch to “OFF” position *(see diagrams on page 7)*.

Always be sure to unplug power cord from wall outlet and allow to cool completely before changing lamp module.

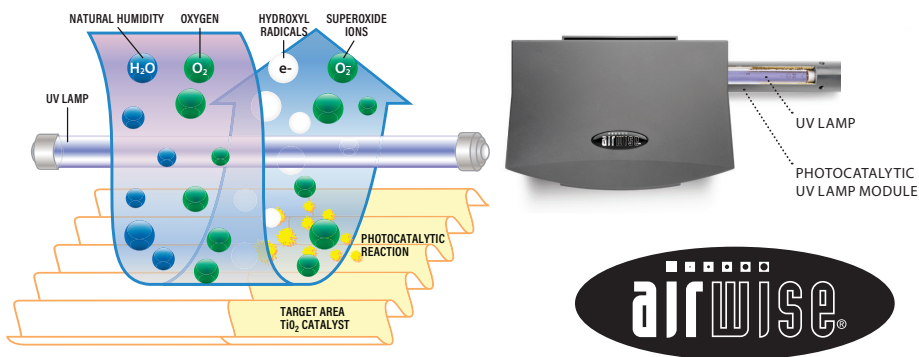

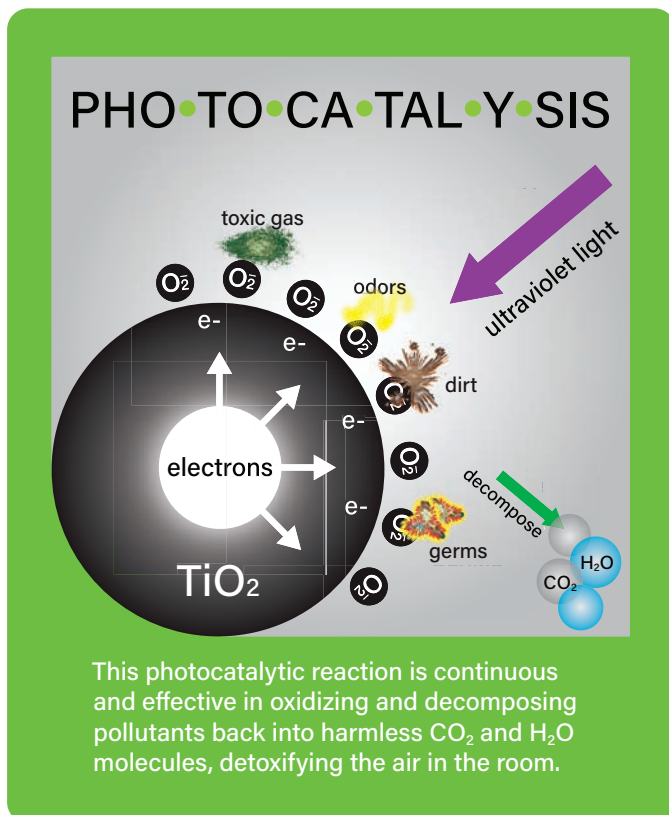

HOW AIRWISE WORKS

Airwise uses humidity from the air to create a photocatalytic reaction between the germicidal UV lamp and the multi-metallic and titanium dioxide coatings on the target area of the lamp module. This reaction produces hydroxyl radicals and superoxide ions. As they are emitted into the room, they destroy microorganisms like bacteria and viruses and oxidize odors, fungi, mold, parasites, and toxic chemical gases. The Purifier also includes Wisepointe® technology, a self-limiting negative ion generator. Negative ions are attracted to airborne positive ions such as dust, pollen, pet dander and smoke. This agglomeration of ions makes the particles heavier than air, thus settling them out of the breathing space.



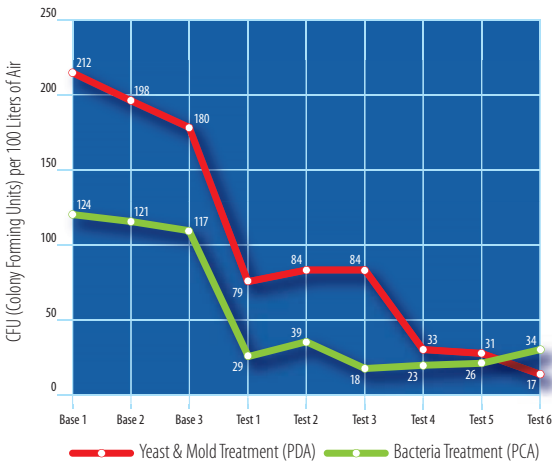
90% MOLD AND BACTERIA REDUCTION

Airwise has proven effective in tests conducted by California Microbiological Consulting, Inc. and Walnut Creek Research Laboratory. They found that common mold and bacteria levels, which are present in 90% of American homes, plummeted 50% or more in the first 24 hours and continued to drop by 90% after 3 days.

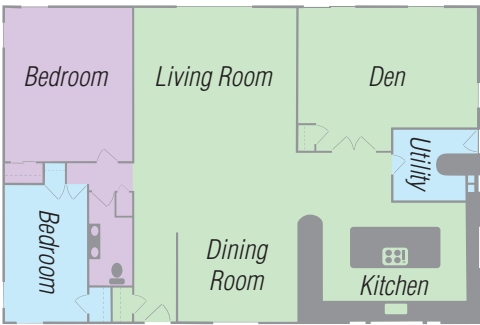


INSTALLATION & OPERATION

Place the Purifier on a flat, level, stable surface in the room where you spend the most time, or close to source of odor. For optimal performance, place the Purifier higher up, such as on a tall piece of furniture. The Purifier includes an extra long power cord to accommodate this optimal placement. To insure proper air flow, keep the unit at least four (4) inches from wall.

Plug Purifier into a standard 120 volt wall outlet only. Press “On/Off” switch to “On” position (see Rear View, page 7). Lamp module will illuminate.

Airwise is most effective in treating open areas. A properly sized Purifier will cause the air to smell clean and fresh. Performance may vary according to atmospheric and/or environmental conditions such as altitude, relative humidity, air movement, severity of existing odor, house design and square footage. If you still detect household odor after a few days, a larger size lamp module may be needed. If you notice a lingering, sterile, metallic odor, or experience burning eyes, a smaller size lamp module may be needed or the Purifier may need to be moved to a larger room.

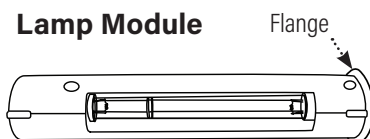
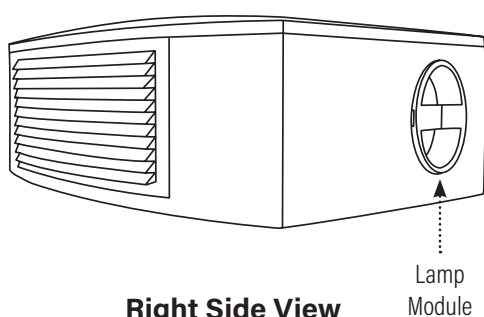
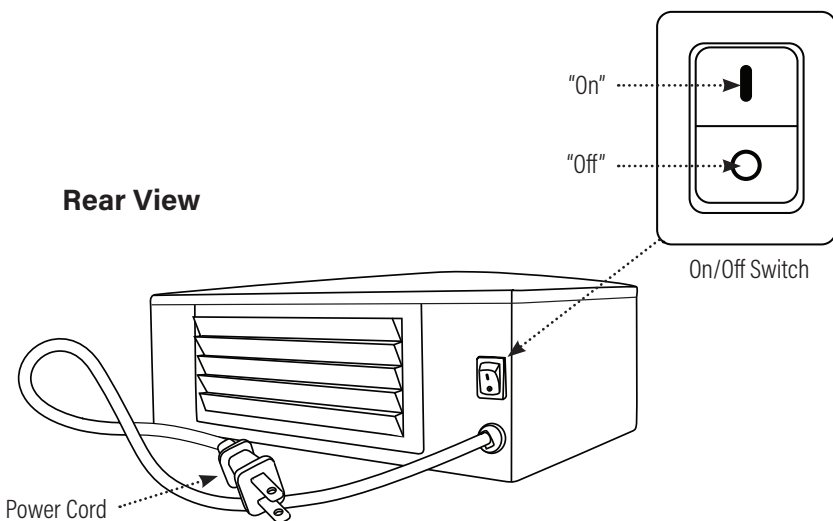

DO NOT mistake the “gold flakes” on the module for dirt or prior use. This multi-metallic coating acts as a catalyst in the production of superoxide ions.

MAINTENANCE—LAMP MODULE REPLACEMENT

The performance of the Purifier will diminish with use. To maintain best treatment, the lamp module should be replaced after approximately 9000 hours of operation, or **once per year if operated continuously**.

To replace the lamp module, press “ON/OFF” switch to “OFF” position. Unplug the Purifier and allow to cool completely. Firmly grip lamp module and pull it out of the Purifier. Install new lamp module by sliding it into Purifier until flange contacts Purifier housing (*see Right Side View, above*). Put the old lamp module in the lamp module box and dispose.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you suspect a problem, check the following:

- Purifier is plugged in properly and turned on (*see Rear View, page 7*).
- The wall outlet is active.
- Lamp module correctly installed.

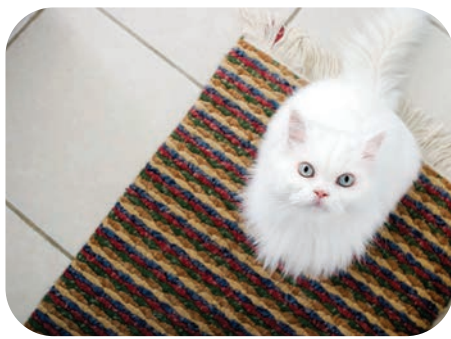


CAUTION!

SERVICE

Contact qualified service personnel for repair if the troubleshooting tips fail.



QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

Q: Does my Purifier need to run all the time?

A: No. You can use your Airwise as needed; however, most owners run the Purifier nonstop to continuously enhance the quality of their air.

Q: Is there any maintenance required?

A: No. Simply replace the lamp module once a year.

Q: What about my clothes? Can I eliminate dry cleaning odors or smoke smell?

A: Yes. Place Airwise in a closet with dry-cleaned or smoke-filled garments for one hour with the door closed.

Q: Does the technology help with pet odor?

A: Yes. It not only removes pet odors, but will drop pet dander out of the air (breathing space).

Q: Can the Purifier be used for travel?

A: Yes. Many owners have an additional small room lamp module which works great in hotel rooms and RVs. Also, consider our portable Airlite® model for travel (*up to 350 square feet*).
